Prior to the annual meeting, Members will have the opportunity to vote for three candidates for director at First Priority Credit Union's East Boston (100 Swift Street, East Boston) from **8:00AM until 4:00PM**. Each member in good standing is eligible to vote one time for three (3) candidates.

FPCU's Board of Directors represents thousands of members to ensure that the credit union is providing the products and services to meet its member's expectations and needs. Board Members help the Credit Union develop the long-range strategic plans while overseeing the financial performance of the Credit Union.

**A Nominating Committee has been established according to First Priority Credit Union bylaws. It has submitted the following candidates:**

**Al Ciccone\***: Al, a US Navy Veteran, has been a member of FPCU for 39 years and has served as a director since 2014; he has served on the Financial Services, Investment, Credit, and Personnel committees, and was the chairman of the Audit committee. Professionally, Al managed USPS's Vehicle Maintenance Facility until his retirement, and is the secretary treasurer of the Boston branch of the National Association of Postal Supervisors.

**Robert Losi\***: Bob has been a member of FPCU since 1980 and has served as a director for more than 25 years, with several years as the Board's chair. A lifelong postal employee, serving in all ranks of the USPS, Bob is running to ensure that FPCU remains a financial institution that supports the financial interests of all of its membership.

**J. Mike Powers**: As a member of the credit union for more than 40 years, Mike and his family have been the beneficiaries of the outstanding financial services provided by FPCU. Mike worked with the postal service for more than 37 years, holding positions ranging from casual carrier to clerk, supervisor, postmaster and ultimately district manager. Throughout his membership and career, Mike has acquired a variety of skills that he hopes to share as a director.

**Carlton Tarpinian\***: Cary has served as a FPCU director since 2013 and is seeking reelection. Cary, who has worked in commercial real estate for 35 years, is seeking reelection to continue to improve FPCU for its members and its community.

**Miles Walcott**: Miles has been a member of FPCU since 1981 and has worked for the Postal Service since 1980. He started as a letter carrier and worked his way up to a supervisor and acting postmaster. For the past 19 years, Miles has served as a Labor Relations Specialist, handling employee and labor issues. He is seeking a seat on the Board to ensure that FPCU will provide the financial support to all of its members that it has provided to him: FPCU helped Miles purchase his first home and secure many auto and personal loans over the last 41 years.
